This practice group is dedicated to assisting individuals who have been seriously injured in motor vehicle accidents. David also acts on behalf of bodily injury plaintiffs involved in aviation and boating accidents, as well as occupiers liability claims and recreational injury claims.

David has a special interest in handling claims involving chronic neuromuscular / musculoskeletal injuries such as thoracic outlet syndrome, temporomandibular joint disorder, reflex sympathetic dystrophy / complex regional pain syndrome, fibromyalgia, facet joint injuries and chronic pain, as well as psychiatric, orthopaedic and brain injury claims.

David appears frequently as counsel at all court levels in British Columbia, including the Federal Court of Canada and the Federal Court of Appeal. David also regularly appears as counsel before various provincial administrative boards and tribunals, such as WCAT. He is a frequent presenter at various insurance industry and bodily injury conferences.
